# DISASTERS IN SOUTH WALES MINING

### FEARED LOSS OF FIFTY-TWO LIVES IN EXPLOSION 12 MILES FROM PIT SHAFT.

## DEADLY AFTER-DAMP CAUSES RESCUE OPERATIONS TO BE ABANDONED.

dliery disasters—one in South Wales and the other in the Nottinghamshire coalfield—occurred to-day, and in each instance there was a heavy loss of life.

Thirty men are entombed in the Marine Colliery, Cwm, Ebbw Vale, where the explosion took place and rescue operations, which were carried out from the early morning hours until after noon at great peril, have had to be abandoned owing to the presence of after-damp.

The explosion occurred one and a half miles from the bottom of the shaft. Fourteen men were killed outright, and the death-roll, it is feared, will reach fifty-two.

In the second disaster seventeen men engaged in sinking operations at Bilsthorpe Colliery, near Mans-field, were overwhelmed by flooding, and fourteen of them are believed to have been killed either by the falling of a water pipe or by drowning.
